1. **Objectives:**

The main objective of Dewasthali Modern Gurukul & Hostel is to provide highly conducive atmosphere to the future generations for bringing their dreams come true in an easier way in a highly secured environment.

The hostel is aimed at giving highly qualitative education to the students so that they can choose their career from the beginning and prepare strategically to achieve their goal in the very first attempt.

- ### 3. **Dewasthali Modern Gurukul & Hostel** is located in National Capital Region Delhi at Shamli. It is just 2 hours (120 KM) far away from **University of Delhi**. **This hostel** is associated with

Dewasthali Modern Gurukul. This institution is based on modern education and **Sanatan Values.**

Dewasthali Gurukul Hostel is a residence for full time Preparatory and secondary class (from 3rd to 12th Class) students of this Gurukul.

1.5 The internal administration and discipline of the hostel is vested in the warden who is assisted by the hostel committee members and staff. The policies of the hostel are decided by the Governing Body of the Gurukul under the overall guidelines and policies of **Premkul Mission Trust.**

1.6 Applications for admission to Hostel should be made in the prescribed form which can be obtained either from the Hostel Office or from the **Dewasthali Modern Gurukul.** The application form must be accompanied with application fee of Rs. 200 to be paid electronically or cash at the counter. The application form without fee payment will not be accepted. The application should be submitted in the Hostel Office in accordance with the time schedule notified on the Notice Board of the Hostel or Website of the Gurukul.. A fresh application is needed every year. The Warden has the final authority in deciding the admissions. Before actual admission to the Hostel, every applicant has to produce documentary evidence that he/she has already been admitted to the Gurukul.

2.1 Reservation: 50% seats are reserved for girls. If Seats are not filled by the girls, then it will be allotted to boys.

5 Eligibility/Admission Criteria

* Hostel accommodation will be provided only to the students admitted in **Dewasthali Modern Gurukul** as regular students on yearly basis.

3.2. The Hostel Committee is empowered to verify the credentials and may seek additional information in this regard during interaction with parents/local guardian at the time of admission.

3.3. Admissions to the hostel shall be considered afresh every year, based on performance in the previous year examination.

3.4. No disciplinary action has been taken against the candidate by the Gurukul Discipline Committee or Hostel Committee.

3.5 The student should have passed the Previous Year.

3.6 The **Gurukul** reserves right to relax the conditions depending upon availability of seats.

3.7 Suppression of the facts or wrong information pertaining to any of these eligibility criteria would make the students liable to disciplinary action as deemed fit by the Hostel Committee.

5. RULES AND REGULATIONS

I. RESIDENCE RULES

- 5.1. No resident is allowed to exchange his/her room or his/her partner without the prior written permission of the warden.
- 5.2. Residents are not allowed to handover keys of their rooms to any person other than the Hostel Staff.
- 5.3. Every resident is responsible for the care of the hostel property. Residents found responsible for any damage to the hostel property will be charged for damage, individually or collectively, as the case may be, and disciplinary action will be taken as per rules.
- 5.4 Every resident is compulsorily a member of the Hostel Mess.
- 5.5 Residents should intimate in writing to the Hostel Office immediately regarding any changes in the addresses, email-ids and telephone/mobile no. of parents and local guardians duly verified by the parents/guardian.
- 5.6 To inculcate the habit of cleanliness and promoting dignity of labour among the students, the residents will clean their own rooms and washrooms themselves. For this a suitable reward system will be developed the Hostel Committee in consultation with Hostel Council.
- 5.7 The common areas will be cleaned by the house keeping staff.

6. LEAVE RULES

- 6.1 All residents are not allowed to go outside the hostel campus except the Gurukul to attend classes or sports activities.
- 6.2 Out station leave will be given only on a letter from the parents/local guardian.
- 6.3 Any student failing to return to the hostel after expiry of his/her leave, without prior intimation, will be liable to disciplinary action which could be expulsion from the hostel.

7. GUEST RULES

- 7.1. Parents/family members of the residents are permitted to stay as guest in the guest house with prior recommendation of the Warden and approval of the Principal for not more than one day. They are required to pay a sum of Rs. 1000/- per day as room rent in advance, with mess facility.
- 7.2. No un-authorized relatives are allowed to visit the ward.
- 7.3. Application for Guest House accommodation is available in Hostel Office

9. **MODE OF PAYMENT:** Fee will be accepted only in ONLINE Payment Modes.

9.1 Fee for Foreign Students: Besides other charges a fee of Rs. 20, 000/- would be charged annually from foreign students at the time of admission and every year on re-admission.

10. Refund of Caution Money: No fee is refundable except the caution money which will be refunded by RTGS after the resident has paid all the dues and vacated the Hostel. The refund of caution money can be claimed in the prescribed form available in the Hostel office not later than one year of the date of their leaving the Hostel.

10.1: Default in payment of Annual /half yearly Charges: If Half yearly charges are not paid by 10th of the concerned month a fine of Rs. 50/- for each day of default will be charged after that date. Beyond 30th of the month, failure to pay the dues will lead to withdrawal of the room allotment and mess facility without any prior notice. All residents going out of Hostel during vacations or otherwise, should make arrangement for the payment of dues by due date.

10.2: **Rebate on Mess Fee:** Rules regarding rebate in mess fees in case of absence from the Hostel are as follows:

10.3: No rebate shall be allowed except in the case of absence from the Hostel for not less than 10 consecutive days in a month with prior intimation given in writing to the Hostel Office in the prescribed form

10.4: The rebate form for mess has to be filled in advance, before departure. In any case no mess rebate will be granted to the resident who will fill-up the form after returning to the Hostel

10.5: The rate of rebate will be Rs.50/- per day subject to a maximum of 30 days in a year.

11: FACILITIES

DINING HALL

11.1: There shall be a separate **Mess Committee** for the hostel under the general supervision of the Warden. The Mess Committee will function in accordance with the Mess rules framed by the Warden. The accounts of the Mess will be maintained by the Hostel Office.

11.2: Food will not be served outside the Dining Hall for anyone (residents or their guests). In case of illness, a resident may be allowed to have sick diet in his/her room with the Warden's permission.

11.3. Those who are late from class for any meal or want a meal earlier must inform in advance to the mess manager in writing for special arrangements. Packed lunch for those who can't come for lunch can be arranged by the mess manager only if prior intimation is given.

11.4.: No property shall be removed from the dining hall under any circumstance.

11.5 Non-resident dining member (NRDM) facility can be made available for the bonafide students of the Gurukul .

11.6: Coupon facility shall be made available for day scholars, staff of the college and guest of the residents to have food in the mess.

11.7: Meals will be served in the dining hall during the following hours:

12 LIBRARY

12.1: For study and borrowing books, the Gurukul library is kept open 24 hours.

13 RECREATION ROOM

13.1 The hostel has one recreation room where television viewing facility is provided. It will remain open during 19:00 to 21:00 hours.

14 SPORTS/ GYMNASIUM

14.1. The Gurukul has indoor facility of badminton, table tennis, carom, chess and gymnasium and archery as an outdoor. Cricket practice facility is also available.

15 MEDICAL CARE

15.1 First-Aid box is available in the hostel. In case of a medical emergency, resident is taken to the nearest hospital and the local guardian is duly informed. The local guardian is required to take charge thereafter and the entire responsibility for treatment and expenses will be born by the parents/local guardian and the college will not be responsible in any way for the further course of treatment. Residents are strongly advised not to use self-prescribed medicine in case of illness.

16 BANKING

16.1: If any student has extra money with him/her. He/she shall deposit the money in warden office and should get a passbook for the same. He/she may withdraw money whenever needed. No time and no number of withdrawal is fixed.

16.2: There is a branch of **Punjab National Bank** just 200 meters from the Gurukul. Parents may get an account open for their wards there. Student will not be allowed to visit the bank. He/she will have to take assistance from the warden for withdrawal of money from the bank. Bank time schedule will have to be followed in this regard.

16.3: There is a cafeteria in the **Vidhyapeeth Campus** run by a contractor under the supervision of the Cafeteria Committee. Residents are advised to make payments to avail the facility.

17. GENERAL DISCIPLINE

17.1: No mobile phone or any other electronic devices are allowed to bring in the hostel.

17.2: Only laptop without SIM card is allowed for education purposes.

17.3: Student shall not play any music on their Laptop. No music system, device is allowed to bring in the hostel.

17.4: Only Hostel phone will be used for getting incoming calls from the parents on the scheduled time only.

18. RAGGING in any form is strictly prohibited within the college premises or any other part of **Dewasthali Modern Gurukul**

18.1. Any individual or collective act or practice of ragging constitutes gross indiscipline and shall be dealt with management rules.

18.2: Residents must maintain proper decorum in the hostel. Severe action will be taken against students, who abet other students, whether in breaking the rules or in undermining the discipline of the hostel.

18.3. Every resident must take proper prior permission from the administration in writing about his/her absence from the Hostel with his/parents.

18.4. Only two guardian will be authorised to visit the ward only after prior appointment from the Hostel authorities. For getting authorisation of guardians, an application along with Adhar Card of them, must be given to the warden.

18.5: Residents are advised not to keep expensive items of large sums in their room. It also becomes the highest obligation and responsibility of all residents that they must keep the **Gurukul hostel** free from Polythene and other pollutants to ensure pollution free environment and refrain themselves to be part of any unlawful act including ragging to avoid any severe disciplinary action from the Gurukul and the Hostel authorities. Grant of hostel facility is a special facility and privilege. Every resident is expected to conduct him/herself with discretion, pursue his/her studies sincerely and attend his/her classes regularly.

18.6: Residents must carry the Hostel Identity Card with them and produce the same on demand by Security Guard and College/Hostel officials.

18.7: Gross indiscipline of any kind, irregularity in payment of dues and poor class attendance record will be treated as disqualification for readmission.

18.7: Residents are advised not to paste posters on the walls and doors of the Hostel and college premises. Graffiti is strictly prohibited.

18.8: Hostel rules and regulations are subject to change from time to time and these will be notified as and when required. Residents are liable to fine/expulsion for breach of these directives.

20 Rules for Discipline:

Maintenance of Discipline among students of the Gurukul

- All powers relating to discipline and disciplinary action are vested in the Principal.
- The Principal may delegate all or such powers as he/she deems proper to the Proctor and to such other persons as he/she may specify in this behalf.
- Without prejudice to the generality of power to enforce discipline under these rules the following shall amount to acts of gross indiscipline:
 - (a) physical assault, or threat to use physical force, against any member of the teaching and non-teaching staff of any Institution/Department and against any student within the Dewasthali Campus.
 - (b) carrying of, use of, or threat to use of any weapons;
 - (c) any violation of the provisions of the Civil Rights Protection Act, 1976;
 - (d) violation of the status, dignity and honour of students belonging to the scheduled castes and tribes;
 - (e) any practice-whether verbal or otherwise-derogatory of women;
 - (f) any attempt at bribing or corruption in any manner;
 - (g) wilful destruction of institutional property;
 - (h) creating ill-will or intolerance on religious or communal grounds;
 - (i) causing disruption in any manner of the academic functioning of the Gurukul.
 - (j) **Ragging as per Gurukul rules:**
 - Without prejudice to the generality of his/her powers relating to the maintenance of discipline and taking such action in the interest of maintaining discipline as may seem to him/her appropriate, the Principal, may in the exercise of his/her powers aforesaid order or direct that any student or students-
 - (a) be expelled; or
 - (b) be, for a stated period rusticated; or
 - (c) be fined with a sum of rupees that may be specified; or
 - (d) That the result of the student or students concerned in the Examination or Examinations in which he she or they have appeared be cancelled.
 - The Principals of the Gurukul shall have the authority to exercise all such disciplinary powers over students in the Gurukul.
 - Without prejudice to the powers of the Principal and the Proctor as aforesaid, detailed rules of discipline and proper conduct shall be framed. These rules may be supplemented, where necessary, by the Principals of Gurukul.
 - At the time of admission, every student shall be required to sign a declaration that on admission he/she submits himself/herself to the disciplinary jurisdiction of the Principal, who is authorised to exercise maintain discipline under the Acts, the Statutes, the Ordinances and the Rules that have been framed there under by the Gurukul.

ORDINANCE A

Under the Acts, the Statutes, the Ordinances and the Rules that have been framed there under by the Gurukul.

Rule: A

Prohibition of and Punishment for Ragging

- Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited, within the premises of **Dewasthali Vidyapeeth** and any part of Gurukul Campus, system as well as on public transport.
- Any individual or collective act or practice of ragging constitutes gross indiscipline and shall be dealt with under this **Rule** .
- Ragging for the purposes of this **Rule A** means any act, conduct or practice by which dominant power or status of senior students is brought to bear on students freshly enrolled or students who are in any way considered junior or inferior by other students and includes individual or collective acts or practices which-
 - (a) involve physical assault or threat to use of physical force;
 - (b) violate the status, dignity and honour of women students;
 - (c) violate the status, dignity and honour of students belonging to the scheduled castes and tribes:

(d) Expose students to ridicule and contempt and affect their self-esteem; (e) entail verbal abuse and aggression, indecent gestures and obscene behaviour..

- The Principal of **Dewasthali Gurukul** shall take immediate action on any information of the occurrence of ragging.

- Notwithstanding anything in Clause (4) above, the Proctor may also suo moto enquire into any incident of ragging and make a report to the Principal, of the identity of those who have engaged in ragging and the nature of the incident.

- The Proctor may also submit an initial report establishing the identity of the perpetrators of ragging and the nature of the ragging incident.

- If the Principal of The Gurukul or Proctor is satisfied that for some reason, to be recorded in writing, it is not reasonably practical to hold such an enquiry, he/she may so advise the **Director** accordingly.

- When the **Director** is satisfied that it is not expedient to hold such an enquiry, his/her decision shall be final.

- On the receipt of a report under Clause (5) or (6) or a determination by the relevant authority under Clause (7) disclosing the occurrence of ragging incidents described in Clause 3 (a), (b), and (c) the **Director** shall direct or order rustication of a student or students for a specific number of days.

- For the purpose of this **Rule A**, abetment to ragging whether by way of any act, practice or incitement of ragging will also amount to ragging.

All disciplinary actions taken against the student must be communicated to the parents of the ward.
